## **NSBA Annual Competitions and Awards**

As an affiliated organisation of the NSBA we invite your Club to take part in our annual sailing competitions, the **Broadland Youth Regatta** and **Ramuz Trophy**, and ask for nominations for the **Tim Whelpton Trophy for Young Achievement** and the **Martin Broom Memorial Trophy for outstanding contribution to Broads boating**.

### **Broadland Youth Regatta**

Waveney and Oulton Broad Yacht Club is hosting the BYR on Saturday 3 September 2022, on Oulton Broad. The regatta is open to any youth or junior member of an NSBA affiliated club or organisation who is under 19 years of age on the day of the event. The regatta is free to enter. There is no minimum number for sailors required to represent an affiliated Club but at least three entrants are required from Clubs competing for the Centenary Salver. ### **The Tim Whelpton Trophy for Young Achievement**

The Tim Whelpton Trophy was donated in 2011 by Anne Whelpton in memory of her husband Tim. The trophy is awarded annually to an individual who is under 25 years of age at the end of the year in recognition of an outstanding performance on the national or international sailing scene and a member of an NSBA affiliated club or organisation. writing, with supporting information, to the NSBA Hon Administrator and be received before 30 September 2022.

### **Martin Broom Memorial Trophy**

This trophy is awarded for an outstanding contribution to Broads boating. There are no limits on the context of the outstanding contribution and nominations can be made for individuals or organisations. Nominations must be made by two individual members of the NSBA who should send their nomination to the NSBA Hon Administrator by the end of September 2022.
